The city's other major industries include processed timber, oil palm production, Shell and tourism. The world famous Gunung Mulu National Park with the Sarawak Chamber, a half an hour flight from the city, is one of the favorite eco-tourism destinations. Miri is also the main tourist gateway for the Loagan Bunut, National Park, Lambir National Park and the Niah Caves National Park.
