Dear **MALAYSIAN FINAL-YEAR DEGREE STUDENTS,**

**RE : MALAYSIAN SOFT SKILLS SURVEY (My3s)**

It is compulsory for all Malaysian final-year degree students in the School of Business and School of Engineering and Science to participate in the My3s survey.

**What is the survey all about?**

The Ministry of Higher Education (MOHE) runs the MyS3 Survey at all public and private universities in Malaysia every two years. The survey covers seven (7) areas: *Communication; Critical Thinking and Problem Solving; Teamwork; Moral and Professional Ethics; Leadership; Lifelong Learning and Information Management; and Entrepreneurship.*

**Impact of the Survey**

The findings of the survey will have some impact on the SETARA (Teaching and Learning) rating for Curtin Sarawak, the results of which will be published nationwide. Currently, Curtin is at Tier 5 (Excellent Status). It is in your interests that the rating is maintained or improved, and one of the ways to do this is through your participation in the survey.

**Who is to be involved?**

It is mandated for all final-year Malaysian students at degree level.

**Why do you need to participate?**

It is a requirement by the Ministry of Higher Education. Absence will only be accepted on medical grounds.

**How will it be conducted?**

The survey is conducted on-line and there are about 180 questions in Bahasa Malaysia. Please note of the following instructions below:

**Instruction to all students**

1. Key in your student's ID (**Your Perth ID**) in the "No. Kad Matrik" column.
2. Key in your identification card (IC) number as the password in the "Kata Laluan" column
3. Click the Login button.
4. Answer all questions and remember to save it before you proceed to the next section.
5. Click the report "**Laporan**" button to review your score
6. Print the last page of your survey (acknowledgement of survey completion) as evidence of participation. Submit the last page of survey to the Curtin staff stationed at the lab.
