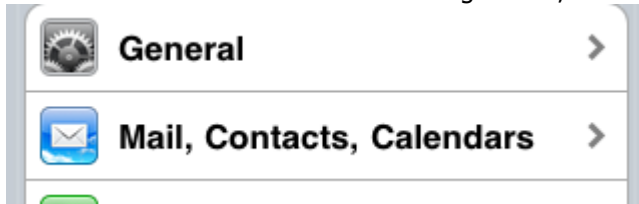


How to Set Up iPhone to Use Exchange

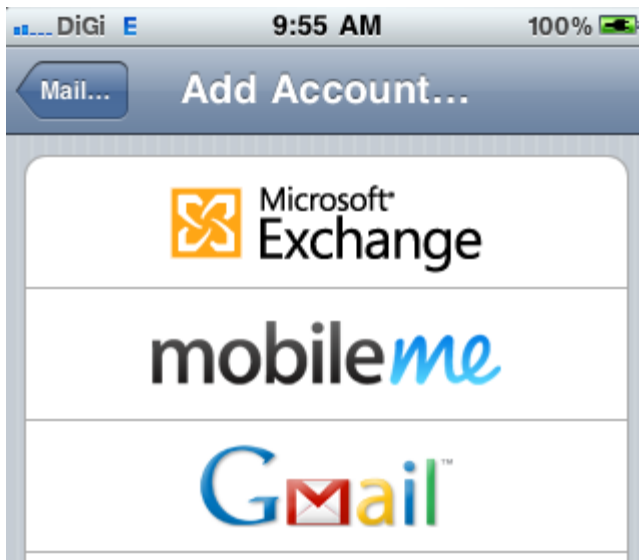
If you have a iPhone and want to connect to an Exchange Server, you do so from the e:mail account setup. You connect to an Exchange Server, as opposed to a standard email address, and your iPhone will download and synchronize with contacts, calendars and other options that your Exchange shares.

Instructions

1 Press the "Menu" button then "Setting > Mail, Contacts, Calendars"



2 Select "Add account" then click "Microsoft Exchange."



3 Enter the details for your Exchange account
